Discussion/Meditation Questions

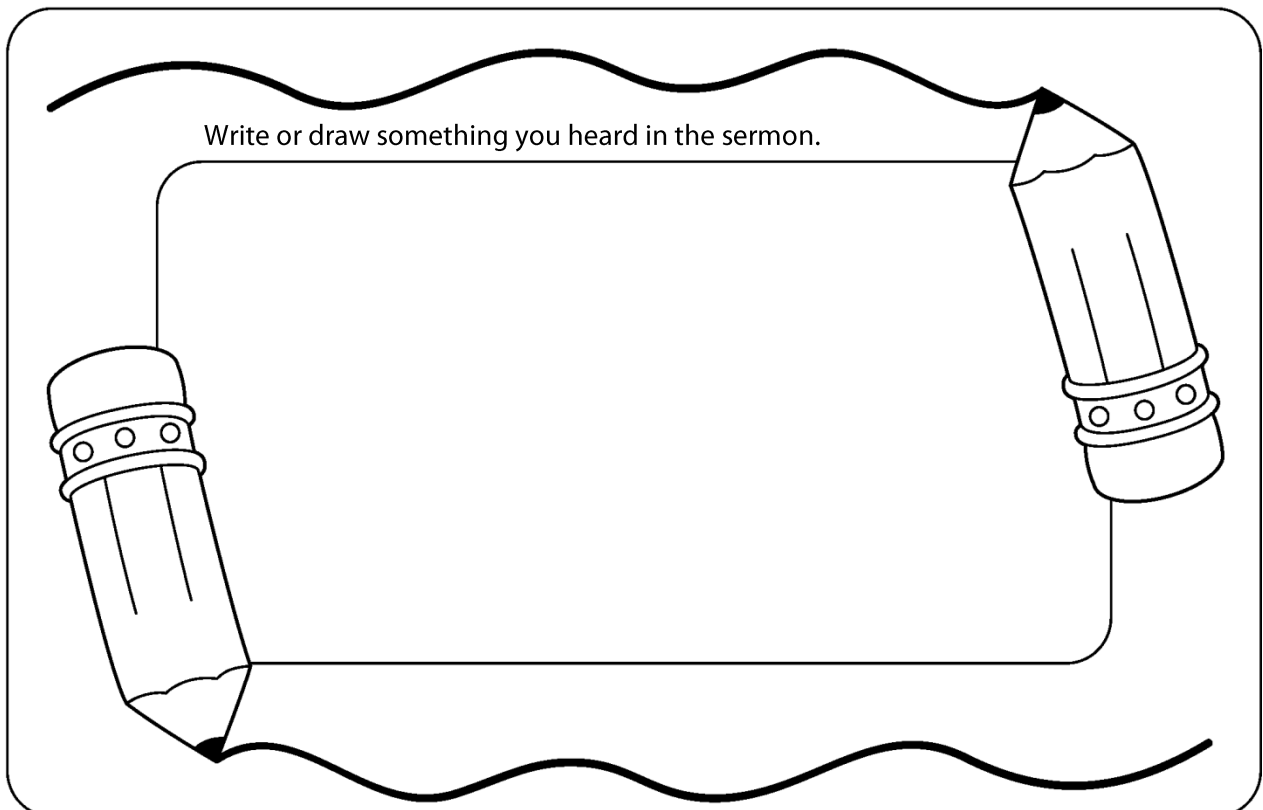
