Key Definitions: Assisted suicide is taking one's own life voluntarily and intentionally with the aid of another. Euthanasia is the practice of intentionally ending the life of another person to stop their suffering. The term "euthanasia" is derived from two Greek words—eu meaning "well" or "good," and thanatos meaning "death." Medical Assistance in Dying (MAiD) is Canada's terminology for state-regulated euthanasia.
