*Sexual immorality is when people act as if they are married when they are not.*

## Sermon Questions

1. Sexual immorality is when God's good gift designed for a husband and wife is twisted and abused (Yes/No).
2. How did the church in Corinth respond to this sin of a man living with his father's wife (his step-mother)?
  - a. They removed him from the church.
  - b. They were arrogant or proud about it.
  - c. They were organizing a class to deal with people who live with their step-mothers.
3. FYI (For Your Information): Pornography is images or movies that show people undressed. God has given us clothing and calls us to be modest and not to use our body for sinful purposes. Pornography must be avoided for the following reasons:
  - a. It is wickedness and it kindles God's wrath.
  - b. It treats men and women as objects and not persons with dignity and worth.
  - c. It destroys marriages and families.
  - d. It leads to abuse and other serious sins.
  - e. It will lead you away from, not closer to God.
  - f. It will ruin your ability to relate to others.
  - g. The result of sin is death.
