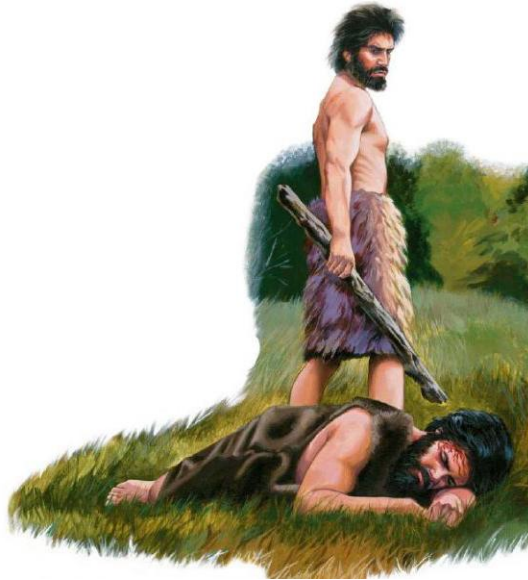


# Cain and Abel
