GEZA ZOLTAN SZIVOS

Geza Zoltan Szivos of Calgary, AB, passed away on Saturday, May 31st, 2025, at the age of 68 years. Geza is survived by his beloved wife, Aniko (nee Kemenesi), his daughter, Adrienn Johnston, her husband, Aleks, and his grandchildren, Logan, Daniel, and Amanda. He is also survived by his brother, Gabor (and sister-in-law Vicki), his goddaughter, Virag Kawakami (her husband, Satoshi Kawakami and their daughters, Hana and Aya), and his niece, Szandra Beres (her husband, Adam Bene, and their children Barna, Balazs, and Bori).

Geza was predeceased by his parents, Geza and Ilonka Szivos. Geza was born in Budapest, Hungary, on March 16th, 1957. He met Aniko during their time together at the University of Miskolc, where they studied Engineering. He married Aniko in 1977, before they graduated together as Mechanical Engineers in 1980.

They moved to Budapest, where their daughter Adrienn was born, and worked in their fields until they moved to Calgary, AB, Canada in 1987.

After moving to Calgary, he worked as a Systems Analyst for NOVA Corporation before his interests turned to IT, and he completed multiple certifications focusing on IBM technology. Geza founded his own software company, SIVCO Inc., in 1995. Aniko joined him at the company a few years later, as well as other employees. As the company grew, Geza moved to Atlanta, GA, USA in 2001.

Geza maintained two residences in Atlanta and Calgary for decades as he and Aniko ran the company together, before he semi-retired in Calgary, staying involved with the company until his death.

Geza was a member of the First Baptist Church of Atlanta and later Fairview Baptist Church in Calgary. He called himself a Born Again Christian and accepted Jesus Christ as his Saviour.

He was devoted to his family and enjoyed spending time with friends. He enjoyed traveling around North America for both business and pleasure, as well as Europe. His favourite vacation destination was Hawaii.

Geza enjoyed watching movies, reading books, and listening to Bible study lessons.
