Discussion Questions

1. The sermon explained that “Everlasting Father” describes Jesus’ functional role rather than confusing him with God the Father. In what ways have you experienced Jesus acting as a father to you—creating life, protecting you, providing for you, or guiding you into the future?
2. The sermon warned against viewing Christ in only one dimension (e.g., just as Savior or just as King). Which title or role of Jesus (Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace, or others like Shepherd or Brother) do you tend to overlook, and how might embracing the overlooked role change your daily walk with him?
3. As the Prince of Peace, Jesus creates peace with God through His cross, preserves that peace eternally, and commands us to pursue peace with others. Where in your life (family, church, workplace, or relationships) do you most need to pursue peace right now, and what practical step could you take this week?
4. The sermon closed by saying that more of Christ brings light and peace into our lives. What specific practice (Scripture reading, prayer, family worship, etc.) could you adopt this week to know and love Jesus more fully in light of these titles?
5. What was your most significant take-away from this passage and sermon?

Discussion Questions for Children

1. The Bible says Jesus is the "Prince of Peace" who fixes the broken things between us and God, and he wants us to be peacemakers too. What is one way you could be a peacemaker this week—at home, at church, or with your friends?
2. Jesus has lots of special names like Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, and Prince of Peace. If you could pick one of these names to thank Jesus for today, which one would you choose and why?
