Discussion Questions

1. How does Jesus *uniquely* fulfill the description of the prophet “like Moses” in this passage (mediator, speaking God’s words, from among the people), and what difference does it make that he is not merely a prophet but the Son of God?
2. The text requires that we “listen” to this prophet. In practical terms, what does genuine listening to Jesus look like in daily life—especially when his words confront our preferences, sins, or cultural assumptions?
3. What biblical tests for a true prophet are given in Deuteronomy 18 and elsewhere in Scripture? How should these tests shape the way we evaluate teaching, preaching, or claims of prophetic insight today?
4. The sermon ends with the personal question, “Will you listen to him?” Where do you most need to heed Christ’s voice right now—regarding truth, repentance, loyalty, or the comfort he offers to those who come to him?
5. What was your most significant take-away from this passage and sermon?

Discussion Questions for Children

1. God promised to send a special prophet like Moses. Who did God send, and why is it important that we listen carefully to what Jesus says?
2. Jesus speaks words of truth, love, and warning. What is one thing Jesus has said that you want to obey or remember this week?
